God's Gang is an afterschool program where children 5 years of age through 6th grade learn to be good neighbors as Jesus has taught us.

God's Gang meets on Wednesday's from 3:30-6:30 p.m. at Sterry Memorial Presbyterian Church. We are located at 28531 HWY 18 in Roswell. God's Gang starts in September and goes through the first two weeks in November. We break for the holidays and resume the the third week in January.

Upon arrival, nutritious snacks are served, followed by recreation and homework time. The students participate in crafts, organized recreation, music, Bible study, and community dinner.
